Entry Fee

\$20.00 per entry per dog per test
(Includes \$3.50 AKC recording fee)

Day of Test entries are **\$25.00** for each entry, and will close 30 minutes prior to roll call at the Field Trial Secretary's table. **Day of Test entries accepted as space allows.** If the trial has not filled, day of show entries will be accepted until 8:00AM each day. Closing date is March 14, 2020, no cancellations refunded after the closing date. All cancellations are subject to \$2.00 processing fee per entry. **Incomplete, unsigned, or conditional entries will not be accepted.** Entries are accepted online at **sugarloafmountainracing.com** or by USPS mail. Online entries are preferred with instant entry confirmation by email and will have an additional \$0.50 processing fee added per entry. All paper entries will be acknowledged by email if legible email address is provided in entry form.

Conditions of Entry

Dogs must have an AKC registration number and be at least one year of age on the day of the trial. Dogs may only run once per test. One dog per entry form. All entries must be accompanied with a check or online payment to be valid. A returned check is not a valid entry. Fast CAT events are open to all dogs at least 12 months of age that are individually registered with the AKC, recorded in the Foundation Stock Service (FSS) program, individually registered with a foreign or domestic registry organization whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration, dogs granted a Purebred Alternative Listing (PAL) number, dogs with AKC Limited or Conditional Registration, or dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners program. Dogs with breed disqualifications and monorchid/cryptorchid dogs are eligible to participate.

What is the Fast CAT?

Coursing is an athletic activity that can tax a dog's physical strength. Dogs that are overweight and/or out of condition may be at greater risk for injury and exhaustion. The inspection committee has the authority to disallow a dog's entry into a test and, in such instances, applicable entry fees will be refunded. At roll call, all dogs will be measured by a wicket to verify handicaps. Bitches in season, lame and unfit dogs will be excused with entry refunded. Please do not bring bitches in season to the test.

Fast CAT is a timed straight 100-yard dash for dogs. Dogs are held at the start line and the coursing lure is activated prompting the dog to follow chasing it to the finish line and into a catch pen. The course is completely fenced, and dogs are run individually. Dogs are timed when they complete the 100-yard dash. The time is converted to Miles Per Hour (MPH).

FORMULA: $204.545 / \text{RUN TIME} = \text{MPH}$
 $\text{MPH} \times \text{HANDICAP} = \text{POINTS (ROUNDED TO NEAREST 0.01)}$

Based on the dog's size at the withers a handicap is applied, and points are earned:

- 18" or greater = Handicap is 1.0
- 12" up to less than 18" = Handicap is 1.5.
- Below 12" = Handicap is 2.0.

MPH X HANDICAP = POINTS

Titles are earned at specific point levels and the highest suffix may appear after the dog's name:

BCAT = 150 points
DCAT = 500 points
FCAT = 1,000 points
FCAT# = Each additional 500 points

Trial Hours

Grounds will be available at 8:00AM. Roll call and exhibitor briefing begins at 8:30AM for morning test and 30 minutes after morning test has been completed. SMKC will make every attempt to facilitate that all entrants will be accommodated with running their dogs in the trials, but it is also the responsibility of each entrant to make an effort to be ready when their dog is called to the line.

Trial Hours

9:00AM each day until all runs are completed. SMKC will do its best to accommodate exhibitors with conflicts if any. However, exhibitors must notify the Field Trial Secretary of possible conflicts and must work their dog into the running order during the regular test schedule. No dogs will be moved up, if you are not available when called your dog will be skipped but not marked absent, the next dog will be called. You may enter your dog in the running order at any time after the dog has been skipped during the test.

SMKC will offer a light blue flat ribbon for a qualifying run.

SMKC will offer placement rosettes at each trial for:

- Fastest 1st-4th in under 12" class
- Fastest 1st-4th in 12" to 18" class
- Fastest 1st-4th in 18" or greater sighthound class
- Fastest 1st-4th in 18" or greater non-sighthound class

SMKC will have a limited number of title rosettes available. Please notify the trial secretary, via email or include with your entry form, if you will be earning the following titles to ensure that the club will have rosettes available.

Trial Site Directions

From Delaware and North:

US-13 South, continue on Business US-13 South Salisbury Boulevard, turn left on Main Street. Turn right on MD-12 Snow Hill Road. Moose Lodge will be on the left.

From Annapolis and West:

US-50 East, continue on US-50 Business East Ocean Gateway, turn right on Ward Street, turn right Main Street. Turn right on MD-12 Snow Hill Road. Moose Lodge will be on the left.

From Norfolk and South:

US-13 North, exit on MD-12 Snow Hill Road toward Salisbury. Moose Lodge will be on the right.

Parking in the rear is advised for easy access to the pavilion and check-in area.

Food Information

Moose Lodge will provide breakfast sandwiches and lunch from 11am-2pm. Menu includes baskets with French fries (chicken tenders, shrimp, and wings) and sandwiches (BLT, hamburger, cheeseburger, hot dogs, fish, etc.) and a Sunday buffet.

There is also a Royal Farms across the road, and other food facilities nearby in town.

Trial Information

- Please pick up after your dogs so we can continue to use this wonderful facility. Any exhibitor caught not cleaning up after their dog will be asked to leave the trial grounds. No refund will be given if this occurs. **A \$5.00 fine will be assessed for any loose dog on the field not competing.**
- **ALL DOGS RUN AT OWNER'S SOLE RISK**
- All entries must be 12 months of age or older on the day of the test.
- All AKC rules regarding sportsmanship and conduct apply.
- This is a rain-or-shine outdoor event. Please plan accordingly. Please bring your own shade, chairs and water.
- An electronic timing system will be used. An electric, continuous loop, plastic strip lure machine will be used.
- The show grounds are not completely fenced. The FAST CAT course will be fenced. See photo for example of sheep fencing used for the course.
- On site bathrooms are available.
- Dogs must be on lead or crated unless running. Flexi-Leads **MUST** be kept at the 2' LOCKED position when used IN and NEAR the building.
- You are responsible for controlling your dogs and children.
- Each dog requires an individual entry. You may use one form to enter one dog for all events. Use the checkbox and mark off each event you wish to enter, \$20.00 per entry.
- The huntmaster is responsible for field safety and therefore he/she is in complete charge of all dogs and handlers on the field. In service to this responsibility, he/she has the authority to stop the lure in any potentially dangerous situation and signal the handler to retrieve the dog on the course.
- Persons exhibiting conduct detrimental to the AKC/SMKC or any dog(s)/other person(s) will be asked to leave the trial site by the Field Committee, maybe disciplined by the AKC, and **entry fees will not be refunded.**
- **No entry fees will be refunded** if the event cannot be started or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or the event-hosting clubs.
- Salisbury Maryland Kennel Club, its agents, members, representatives, volunteers, etc., assume no liability or responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children or spectators before, during, or after this event.
